YOUTH PROGRAMS

Book Buddies - Book Buddies pairs teens and kids with the goal of improving kids' confidence in their reading skills. Kids in grades K - 5th are matched with teen volunteers and spend 30 minutes each week reading aloud during the 6-week series. 
Color Me Calm - Enjoy a relaxing morning, coloring and drinking coffee with new friends. All supplies provided.
